Itinerary Overview: Day 1: Malta – Zagreb – Selce / Crikvenica

We meet our Tour Leader at Malta International Airport and check in for our flight scheduled for departure at 05:50hrs to Zagreb. Upon arrival, after collecting our luggage, we board our coach and begin a pleasant drive towards the coastal town of Selce.

On arrival, we check into our hotel and after some time to relax, we take a short walk to the nearby town of Crikvenica, a popular seaside destination known for its lively promenade, souvenir shops, cafés, pastry shops and restaurants. Free time to explore and enjoy the atmosphere at your own pace.

Later we return to the hotel for dinner. Overnight in Selce.

Itinerary Overview: Day 2: Rijeka – Opatija

Following breakfast, we depart for the charming coastal towns of Rijeka and Opatija. Our first stop is Rijeka, where we enjoy a guided walking tour of the city. During the tour we will discover the main highlights, including the lively city promenade, the Leaning Tower, the Old City Gate, and the Cathedral of St. Vitus. After the tour, there will be some free time to explore the city at your own pace.

We then continue towards Opatija, one of Croatia's most elegant seaside resorts. Here we explore this charming town, known for its beautiful villas, colourful parks, and rich cultural heritage. During our walk we admire the famous Lungomare seaside promenade, the Summer Stage, the iconic statue of the Girl with the Seagull, and the beautiful Angiolina Park. After the visit there will be some free time before returning to the hotel in the evening.

Later we return to the hotel for dinner. Overnight in Selce.

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Itinerary Overview: Day 3: Island of Krk – Krk Town – Vrbnik

After breakfast, we depart for the island of Krk, the largest island in Croatia, which is connected to the mainland by a bridge. Our first stop is the historic town of Krk, where we enjoy a guided walk through its charming old town. Highlights include the ancient city walls, the main square Vela Plaća, the Church of St. Mary, and the Frankopan Castle.

Later we continue to the picturesque village of Vrbnik, famous for its wine production, particularly the local Žlahtina wine. The town is also known for having one of the narrowest streets in the world. Here we enjoy a short walk before returning to the hotel in the afternoon.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Itinerary Overview: Day 4: Plitvice Lakes National Park

Today we visit one of Croatia's most spectacular natural attractions, Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The park is famous for its series of 16 interconnected lakes, crystal-clear waters, and breathtaking waterfalls surrounded by lush forests. The lakes display beautiful shades of turquoise and blue, changing colour depending on minerals and sunlight.

During our visit we admire the impressive Veliki Slap, the highest waterfall in Croatia at 78 metres. We explore the park along wooden walkways that wind through the natural landscape, offering stunning views of the lakes and waterfalls. The visit also includes a scenic boat ride across Lake Kozjak, allowing us to fully appreciate the tranquillity and beauty of the park.

After this unforgettable experience we return to the hotel for dinner. Overnight stay in Selce.

Itinerary Overview: Day 5: Motovun – Rovinj

After breakfast, we head to the beautiful Istria region to visit the historic hilltop town of Motovun. Upon arrival, we take a shuttle bus to the top of the town. Motovun is famous for its breathtaking views and well-preserved medieval charm. Accompanied by a local guide, we explore the town and see its main highlights, including the city walls, the Parish Church of St. Stephen, the bell tower, and the main squares. After the tour, there will be some free time to enjoy the scenery or relax in one of the cafés.

Later we continue to Rovinj, one of the most picturesque towns in Croatia. With a local guide, we explore the charming old town and visit landmarks such as the Church of St. Euphemia, the Balbi Arch, and the famous Grisija Street, where local artists display their works.

Dinner and overnight in Selce.

Itinerary Overview: Day 6: Karlovac – Zagreb

After breakfast, we check out of Hotel Katarina and travel towards the city of Karlovac. Known as the "city of four rivers," Karlovac is also famous for its green parks and relaxed atmosphere. Accompanied by a local guide, we explore the historic centre, including the old star-shaped fortress area, Ban Josip Jelačić Square, the Dr. Franjo Tuđman Promenade, and Vrbanić Park.

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Following the visit, we enjoy a relaxing one-hour boat trip along the Kupa River on board a traditional river boat. Later, we continue our journey to Zagreb, where we arrive in the afternoon and check in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight in Zagreb.

Itinerary Overview: Day 7: Zagreb – Return to Malta

After breakfast, we head to the centre of Zagreb for a guided city tour. During our walk we visit Ban Josip Jelačić Square and King Tomislav Square, and explore the historic Upper Town, including Zagreb Cathedral and the local market area.

After the tour there will be free time for shopping, sightseeing, or enjoying a coffee before we continue to Zagreb Airport for our return flight to Malta, scheduled to depart at 23:00 hrs.
