Itinerary Overview: Day 1 – Arrival in the Black Forest Region

Itinerary Overview: Day 2 – Triberg Waterfalls, Cuckoo Clocks & Lake Titisee

Surrounded by lush greenery and picturesque hills, this emerald lake is a beloved getaway for locals and visitors alike. You will have some free time to explore the lakeside village or relax by the water. In the late afternoon, we return to our hotel in Waldkirch, bringing a perfect end to a day full of nature, culture, and local charm.

Our journey then continues to one of Switzerland’s most iconic natural wonders—Rhine Falls. Considered the most powerful waterfall in Europe, this breathtaking cascade near the town of Neuhausen is truly a sight to behold.
